QUESTION

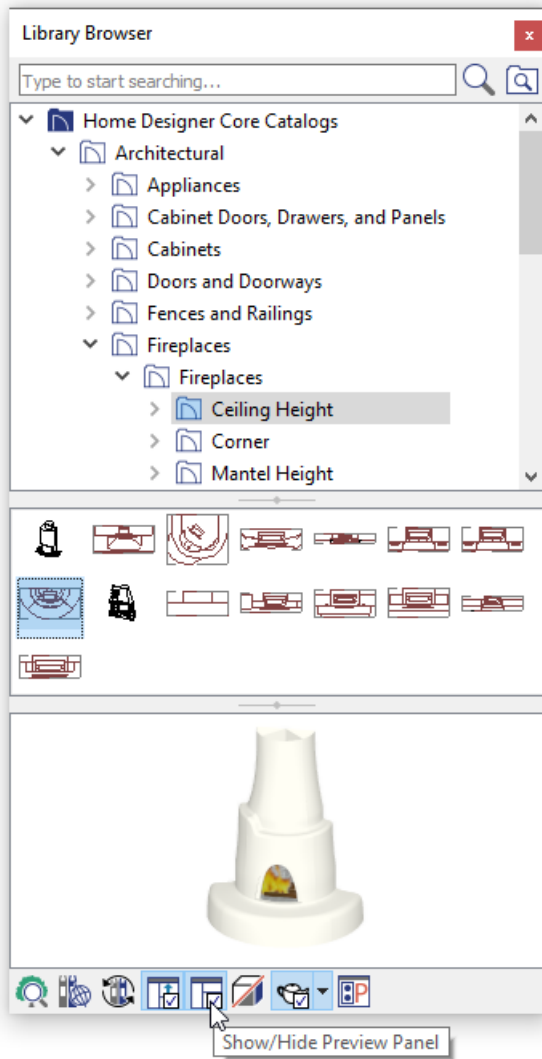
The 3D previews in the Library Browser of my program are missing. How do I get them back?

ANSWER

Both the selection panel and preview panel within the library browser can be toggled on and off. Also, the library browser can be re-positioned and restored back to its default size and location.



To toggle the selection panel and preview panel

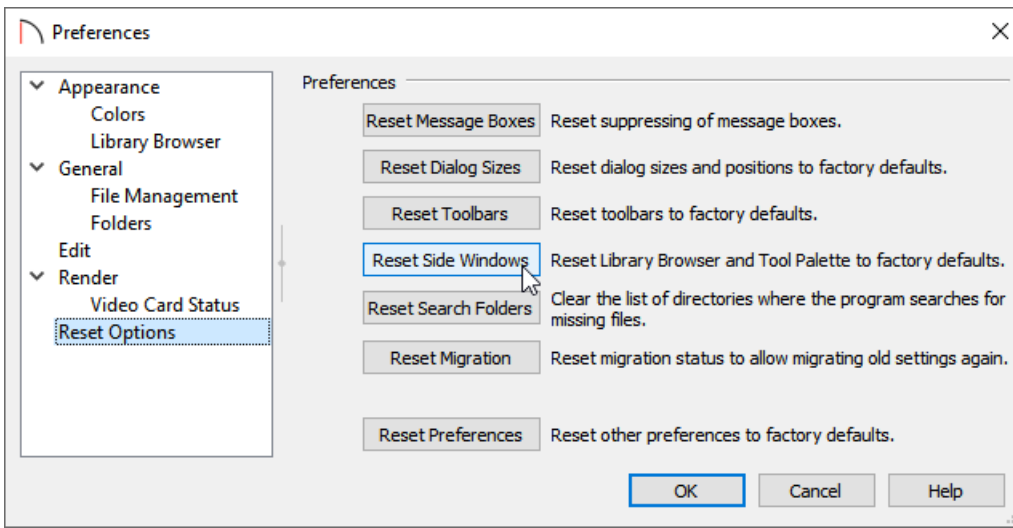
Click on the **Show/Hide Selection Panel**  and **Show/Hide Preview Panel**  tools located at the bottom of the Library Browser.



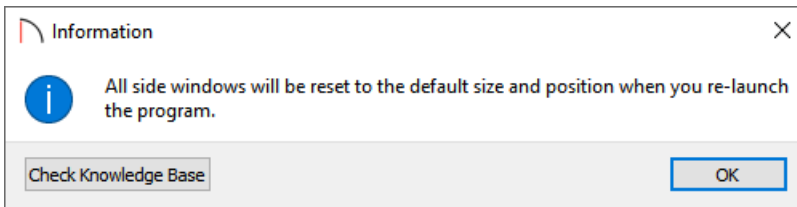
If you still cannot see the preview and selection panels, it may be that you have resized the browser so that they are no longer on the screen. If you cannot quickly resize the dialog to correct this, it is easy to restore it back to its default following the instructions below.


To reset the library browser's size and position

1. Navigate to **Edit > Preferences**  if you're on a Windows computer or **Home Designer > Preferences**  if you're on a Mac.
2. On the **RESET OPTIONS** panel of the **Preferences** dialog that displays, click on the **Reset Side Windows** button.



3. An **Information** dialog will display mentioning that the side windows will be reset once the program is re-launched. Click **OK** and **OK** again to close both of the dialog boxes.



4. **Save**  your work, exit out of Home Designer, and re-launch the program in order to restore the library browser back to its default size and position.
