## QUESTION


I've downloaded and installed a Chief Architect or Home Designer program, but I'm not able to locate it on my Mac system. Why is this?

## ANSWER

Once downloaded and installed, you can find the Chief Architect or Home Designer program in your Mac Applications folder.

## To locate the software

1. From the menu at the top of the screen, select the**Go** menu and then choose the **Applications** option from the list.



**Note:** Alternatively, you can select Finder and click on the Applications option located on the left side of the Finder window.

2. In the **Applications** folder, locate the Chief Architect or Home Designer program that was installed.
